Detailed information about academic assessment and progress for undergraduate and postgraduate students, is set out in the appropriate '<u>Handbook and Regulations'</u>. These regulations are standard across all students whether funded via Financial Aid or not.

Where a student disagrees with an academic outcome they are entitled to appeal, via the <u>University's Appeal Process</u>. Please note this is a separate process to appealing the loss of Financial Aid eligibility (please see below).

## b) Postgraduate Research Students

Students are required to submit monthly reports and achieve the appropriate milestones as laid out by the Doctoral College.
